



TURRAMURRA PUBLIC SCHOOL REPRESENTATIVE CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

Codes of Behaviour provide a supportive framework which promotes appropriate behaviour at school and when representing the school. The following code applies to all activities and events that are school-related and when representing or acting on behalf of the school and is designed to highlight the expectations of **respect, responsibility** and **personal best**.

Students will:

- Uphold the school's expectations of **respect, responsibility** and **personal best** at all times.
- Behave in a manner that does not endanger the health, safety and wellbeing of themselves or others.
- Abide by all health and safety rules and procedures operating within the school and other locations at which the students may visit.
- Ensure that their actions do not bring the school into disrepute.
- Always wear the correct school or sport uniform.
- Ensure all school and homework is complete. If homework is not completed for three weeks in any one term, students will **not** be able to represent the school at the next event.
- Understand that they will **not** be able to represent the school at the next event if they receive three negative behaviour slips in any one term.
- Ensure that appropriate behaviour is displayed in **all** lessons, with **all** teachers and visitors.
- Be aware that homework is to be complete before attending rehearsals or sport training.
